The most obvious difference is that they do not have a rear staircase. These cost more than a regular wrightbus on the same chassis. So far 6 prototypes were built, then another 2 prototypes followed. But I highly doubt the bus will take of because operators are not going to love the styling so much that they will pay extra for it.
